Amphitheatre to commemorate Civil War with Evansville Brass Quintet

LINCOLN CITY, IND.----The Evansville Brass Quintet will perform at Lincoln Amphitheatre to commemorate the sesquicentennial of the beginning of the Civil War.

The five piece band will perform selections that were made popular in during the mid-1800s including Stephen Foster's "Jeanie with the Light Brown Hair," Edmund Jaeger's "Indiana Polka," and Daniel D. Emmett's "Dixie" on April 17, 2011, at 2 p.m. CDT. The program will run for one hour and fifteen minutes with an intermission.

The Evansville Brass Quintet began in 1986 and consists of two trumpets, one French horn, trombone, and tuba.
